

Warfarin is an anticoagulant chemical which, if ingested by human beings, domestic animals, pets or wildlife may reduce the clotting ability of the blood and internal hemmorhage may result. In case baits are swallowed, give a tablespoonful of salt in a glass of warm water and repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Call for a physician immediately.

Do not reuse empty container. Destroy it by burying with waste or burning. Stay away from smoke or fumes.

Note for Physicians: When a human has been known to have ingested Warfarin, blood transfusions combined with intravenous injections and oral doses of Vitamin K are indicated as in the case of hemorrhage caused by overdoses of Dicumarole.
