May be fatal if swallowed.

Warfarin Sodium is an anticoagulant chemical which if taken by humans, domestic animals, pets or wildlife may reduce the clotting ability of the blood and serious hemorrhage may result. In case baits are swallowed, give a table-spoonful of salt in a glass of warm water and repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Call for a physician immediately.

Do not reuse empty container. Destroy it by burying with waste or burning. Stay away from smoke or fumes.

**Note for Physicians:** When a human has been known to have ingested Warfarin Sodium, blood transfusions combined with intravenous injections and oral doses of Vitamin K are indicated as in the case of hemorrhage caused by overdose of Dicumarol ®.
