Subject: Designation of Petroleum Distillate as an Inert Ingredient
EPA Registration Number 432-449
Submission dated April 1, 1993

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Submit one (1) copy of the finished labeling prior to releasing the product for shipment.

1. Based upon the toxicity category III results of both the eye irritation and dermal toxicity studies, add the following statements to the **PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS** paragraph which begins "Avoid contact with eyes....": Causes eye irritation. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin.
2. Revise the hospital-use precautionary statement, which appears in the **DIRECTIONS FOR USE** section of the product label, as follows: In hospitals, remove patients prior to treatment. Ventilate the area for 2 hours prior to returning the patients.
3. Revise the paragraph which begins "In food handling areas...." as follows:

In food handling areas, cover or remove all food during treatment. In commercial food handling facilities, do not use while food processing is underway. All food processing surfaces, equipment, utensils, benches, and shelving should be covered or removed prior to treatment, or thoroughly washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse prior to use.
4. You may wish to revise the respective footnote to the ingredients statement to include the current company name 'Roussel Uclaf' rather than "Roussel Bio", as well as including the current address of record.

In hospitals, patients should be removed prior to treatment. Also for use in buses, automobiles, trucks, boxcars and ship cargo holds. Also for use in dog kennels and horse stables. In horse stables, not for application if horses will be used for food.

In food handling areas, food should be removed or covered previous to treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered or thoroughly cleaned before using. Apply only when facility is not in operation.

STORAGE: Keep in locked storage area.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Remove protective cap. Aim spray at pest.
Push button to spray.

INDOOR: TO KILL WASPS, HORNETS
Application should be made in late afternoon at rest. Spray liberally into hiding places, particularly under rafters, corners, and other possible. Saturate areas in and around nest as necessary.

TO KILL SPIDERS - Spray directly at spiders. Repeat applications to the web crevices which harbor spiders.

OUTDOORS: TO KILL WASPS, HORNETS
Application should be made in late afternoon at rest. Aim spray at nest openings, eaves, chimneys, cracks and crevices around nest openings. Contact as soon as possible. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL SPIDERS - same as directions for indoors.

TO KILL TENT CATERPILLARS - Apply when caterpillars are young and before they have spun their webs. For best results, apply in the late afternoon when caterpillars have returned to their tents, and totally saturate on all sides.
