The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

As new labels are prepared:

1. For Reg. No. 432-623, remove aromatic petroleum solvent as an active ingredient and include its total with inert ingredients. Add "Contains petroleum distillate" below the ingredient statement. Update the Statement of Practical Treatment to cover other routes of exposure.
2. For Reg. No. 432-493, replace the ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARD statement with the statement from the Resmethrin Standard for outdoor uses (not RESTRICTED USE).

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Spray outdoor areas of the yard, patio and camp ground with direction of a slight breeze.
Control flies, mosquitoes and gnats up to 21 feet away, up to 21 feet away. Shake well before using. Point spray nozzle away from face to be treated. Press down valve button and allow spray fog to drift. For larger areas, best results are obtained by spraying in short bursts. Allow the fog to drift into the areas of infestation. Spray well. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area.

FLYING INSECTS: Reduce annoyance from flies, mosquitoes and other flying insects by spraying from a distance of 4 to 6 feet away from flowering plants where the insects may be resting. Avoid heavy wetting of plant foliage and other breeding areas. Repeat as necessary. Spray well. Thoroughly wet the nesting area during the evening when the insects are active.

CRAWLING INSECTS: Spray directly on ants, centipedes, cockroaches, and other crawling insects around garbage cans, picnic sites and camp grounds. Infestations of ants may be controlled by spraying ant hills for best results. Spray in short bursts of 2 to 3 seconds. Control of Brown Recluse Spider and Black Widow Spider is not guaranteed.
