SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

CAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with skin. Harmful if swallowed. Not for indoor use. While spraying for flying insects outdoors, hold container 4 to 6 feet away from plants and shrubs. Direct spray to fill the air around these plants without heavily wetting the plant foliage. Avoid smoking while spraying. Cover food before spraying. Do not spray on food crops. Direct spray away from people or animals. Allow spray to disperse for several minutes before entering the treated area.

Spray outdoor areas of the yard, patio and camp ground when there is no breeze or spray in the direction of a slight breeze.

Kills flying insects up to 10 feet away.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Shake well before using. Point spray nozzle away from face and in the direction of the space to be treated. Press down valve button and allow spray fog to fill the air where flying pests linger. For larger areas, best results are obtained by spraying in the direction of a slight breeze that allows the fog to drift into the areas of infestation. Spray while moving away from treated areas. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary.

FLYING INSECTS - Reduce annoyance from flies, mosquitoes, moths and gnats by directing spray from a distance of 4 to 6 feet from flowering plants, shrubbery, and grass to where the insects may be resting. Avoid heavy wetting of plant foliage. Also spray around garbage cans and other breeding areas. Repeat as necessary. Spray directly on wasps and hornets. Thoroughly wet the nesting area during the evening when these insects are least active.

CRAWLING INSECTS - Spray directly on spiders. Spray in short bursts of 2 seconds at a 3 to 4 foot distance for control of Brown Recluse Spider and Black Widow Spider. Repeat application as necessary.
