 Your Brand SBP-1382®/Bioallethrin (0.20% + 0.125%) Aqueous Pressurized Spray for  
 House & Garden

 Submission dated May 18, 1993

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Submit two (2) copies of the finished labeling prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the product label is enclosed for your records.

- Delete the statement "Contains petroleum distillates" from the product label, as this is not appropriate for products which contain less than 10% petroleum derivatives.
- Revise the statement which begins "All food processing", which appears in the paragraph "NOTICE" to read as follows:


All food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered or removed prior to treatment, or thoroughly washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse prior to use.

- Expand the STORAGE AND DISPOSAL statement as follows:

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.  
**STORAGE:** Store in cool, locked storage area inaccessible to children, and away from heat, sparks or open flame.  
**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper, and discard in trash.

### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is highly toxic to fish. For terrestrial uses, do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. ### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Shake well before each use. Remove protective cap. Push button to spray.  
**CONTROL HOUSEHOLD PESTS:** For house flies, mosquitoes, gnats, wasps, roaches, earwigs, and other sources which attract these insects. Fill the area. Keep the room closed for at least 15 minutes. Repeat as necessary.

**For Crawling Insects:** Roaches, earwigs, sowbugs, silverfish, and other insects. Spray in places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas, open doorways, baseboards, and storage areas. Spray directly on insects.  
**ANTS:** Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray as often as necessary.

**ANIMAL PESTS:** Fleas: Apply directly to animal. Do not spray on other areas. Fleas must contact skin and inure good away while spraying. Apply until hair is thoroughly moist. Repeat within 24 hours of first application. Repeat until flea infestation is thoroughly controlled. Repeat at the rate of two seconds per linear foot while spraying entire inside surface of dog house. Repeat as necessary.  
**OUTDOORS TO REDUCE ANNOYANCE FROM FLYING INSECTS:** (mosquitoes, house flies, biting flies and flying moths) Follow precautions listed above. Hold container 18 inches above ground. Spray these areas with a slow sweeping motion. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the area. Repeat as necessary.

**OUTDOORS TO PROTECT ORNAMENTAL PLANTS:** To protect ornamental plants from flying insects, spray directly on insects. Hold container 18 inches above ground. Spray for one to three seconds. Repeat as necessary to obtain control.

**USE WITH CAUTION:** on young tender foliage. Avoid use on plants such as ash and camellias may be subject to burn injury. For adult whiteflies, two-spotted mites and mealybugs, thoroughly cover the infested area. Use several applications if necessary.

**PROTECT HOUSE PLANTS:** Spray infested African violets, coleus for listed pests. Leave the sprayed area when treatment is completed.

**NUISANCE PESTS-ON OR ENTERING BUILDINGS:**  
**Wasps:** Applications should be made in late evening into hiding and breeding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Spray directly on stray wasps that enter buildings.  
**Ants:** Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray as often as necessary.  
**Spiders:** Direct short burst of spray on spiders and webs.  
**Earwigs:** Spray directly on earwigs in crevices and on patio floor and doorway entrances.
