**CONTROL HOUSEHOLD PESTS:**  
**FOR HOUSE FLIES, MOSQUITOES, AND GNATS:** Close door, open window, and spray upward, direct spray mist to all parts of the room, especially areas which attract these insects. Fill the room with mist, then leave room closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when ready to re-enter.  
**FOR CRAWLING INSECTS:** Roaches, earwigs, grain mites, etc. Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, pipes and sinks, under refrigerators, baseboards, and stoops, etc., where possible.

**ANTS:** Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray as often as necessary.

**OUTDOORS - TO REDUCE ANNOYANCE FROM FLYING INSECTS:** Reduce mosquito, gnats (midges), house flies, and other flying insects by spraying their resting areas. Follow precautions listed above. To reduce annoyance from these flying insects, treat ornamental plants and shrubs and garden areas. Spray these areas at a rate of from 1 to 3 seconds per cubic yard of space while the insect is present. To reduce annoyance from these flying insects, treat ornamental plants and shrubs. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dry before re-entry. Repeat as necessary.

**OUTDOORS - TO PROTECT ORNAMENTAL PLANTS:** To control aphids, exposed thrips, adult whiteflies, leafhoppers, spittlebugs and Japanese beetle on smaller rhododendrons, dogwood, palm, mimosa, toyon, viburnum, euonymus, althea and mimosa webworm larvae on mimosa, spray as directed above. To control of aphids, exposed thrips, adult whiteflies, leafhoppers, Japanese beetles, spray as directed above.

**USE WITH CAUTION** on azaleas, junipers, roses, including climbing roses, and camellias. These plants may be subject to leaf or stem injury.

For adult whiteflies, two-spotted mites and mealybugs be subject to leaf or stem injury. Thoroughly cover the infested area. Use several repetitions as necessary.

**PROTECT HOUSE PLANTS:** Spray infested African violets, philodendron, geranium, etc. Leave the sprayed area when done indoors, and ventilate.

**NUISANCE PESTS - ON OR ENTERING BUILDINGS:**  
**WASPS:** Applications should be made in late evening when they are entering buildings, contacting as many insects as possible. Spray directly on stray wasps that enter buildings.  
**ANTS:** Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray as often as necessary.  
**SPIDERS:** Direct short burst of spray on spiders and remove them.  
**EARWIGS:** Spray directly on earwigs in crevices and other hiding places, patio floor and doorway entrances.
