The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Add the "skull and crossbones" symbol to the front panel of the label. This symbol must appear in close proximity to the signal word "DANGER".
2. Revise the Statement of Practical Treatment for "IF IN EYES" to read:

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention.

Submit five copies of your final printed labeling prior to releasing product for shipment.
