SBP-1382®/Bioallethrin Concentrate 10-5 is intended only for formulating use. The formulator using this concentrate is fully responsible for obtaining EPA registrations for his formulated products.

This product may be formulated into end-use products intended for the following acceptable uses: Domestic Indoor (Household), Domestic Outdoor (Household/ Ornamental), Indoor Food Handling Establishments (Edible product areas), Non-Commercial Greenhouse Ornamentals, Mosquito Control, Commercial Industrial Use, Animal Treatments and holding areas, stored grain, and uncultivated nonagricultural areas.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

**Storage:** Do not store below 40°F. This material may have been exposed to temperatures below 40°F; to insure uniformity, warm to 80°F and mix well before using.

**Pesticide Disposal:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

**Container Disposal:** Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.
