The final printed label submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, however, please note the following comments concerning the inert ingredient of toxicological concern, methylene chloride.

PR Notice 90-1 indicates that Data Call-Ins for original List 1 inerts, which includes methylene chloride, were mailed March 1989. Registrants are encouraged to substitute or remove any List 1 or List 2 inert ingredient from their products by submitting a new Confidential Statement of Formula as a proposed amendment to the registration. Once a registrant submits the revised formulation, registrants may manufacture only the old formulation properly labeled as containing the toxic inert ingredient, [REDACTED] until EPA accepts the new formulation.
