

SBP-1382® MICRO-MIN INSECTICIDE SPRAY 0.5% WITH MINERAL OIL

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Avoid breathing mist. Cover or remove exposed foods. Avoid contamination of cooking utensils and food preparation surfaces. Remove pets and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush skin and eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams, or ponds. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated.

(2 meters) from objects, especially painted surfaces.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE (continued)

To kill wasps, hornets, yellow jackets: Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Spray to saturation nest openings, under eaves, chimneys, cracks and crevices. Contact as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.

To kill fleas and ticks: Spray directly on insects and animal resting areas. Apply spray until area is moist. Treat pet bedding the same way. Also spray entire inside surface of dog houses. Repeat as necessary. Do not allow pets to contact treated areas until spray has dried. Remove or cover animal feed before spraying.

To kill ants: Spray ant trails and hills, and around entries. Repeat as necessary.

To kill spiders: Spray directly on these pests and to the webbing and to all areas which harbor spiders. Repeat as necessary.

To kill cockroaches, crickets, earwigs, sowbugs, centipedes, millipedes: Apply as a contact spray. Direct spray to contact these insects in harborage areas. Spray infested areas until thoroughly wet. Repeat as necessary.

Also, thoroughly spray garbage and refuse areas, especially around poultry houses, barns and similar areas of heavy infestation.

FOR ORNAMENTAL PLANTS

To kill aphids, Japanese beetles, red spider mites, exposed thrips, whiteflies, fungus gnats and plant bugs on certain ornamentals such as: roses, gladioli, azaleas, chrysanthemums. Application: To rid an area of houseflies, mosquitoes, gnats and the above-named insects on the ornamentals listed, walk at a rate of 1 ft./sec. (0.3 meters/sec.) at 90 degrees across the wind, while spraying in the direction of the wind. Repeat this procedure at intervals of 32 feet (10 meters) upwind for at least three sprayings. Allow the wind to carry the spray into, around and through the area to be treated. The spray nozzle should be no closer than 6 ft. (2 meters) to ornamental plants. In cases of heavy infestations, repeat as necessary.

Use with Caution: As with all plants listed above, especially roses and chrysanthemums, there exists a wide variety of species and cultivars, and therefore a wide range of susceptibility to injury. To ascertain possible phytotoxicity, spray a few plants as described above, wait 24 hours, and check for possible injury.
