DIRECTIONS

To kill wasps, hornets, yellow jackets, etc. made in late evening when they are hiding and breeding places are possible. Spray to saturate chimneys, cracks and crevices possible. Repeat as necessary. To kill fleas and ticks: Spray resting areas. Apply spray the same way. Also spray on repeat as necessary. Do not allow until spray has dried. Repeat spraying.

To kill ants: Spray ant trails on as necessary.

To kill spiders: Spray directly on to all areas which harbor.

To kill cockroaches, crickets, millipedes: Apply as a contact. These insects in harborage thoroughly wet. Repeat as necessary. Also, thoroughly spray part around poultry houses, to infestation.

FOR ORNAMENTAL

To kill aphids, Japanese beetles, thrips, whiteflies, fungus gnats, etc. on ornamentals such as roses, etc. Application: To rid an area of the above-named insects on 1 of 1 ft./sec. (0.3 meters/sec.) spraying in the direction of intervals of 32 feet (10 m) sprayings. Allow the wind to blow through the area to be treated closer than 6 ft. DISCUSSION: To control nuisance pests around buildings, patios and paved areas. Apply as a contact spray. Spray directly on insects. To kill houseflies, mosquitoes, gnats: apply undiluted using hand-held powered ULV equipment. Avoid staining by holding the spray nozzle at least 6 ft. (2 meters) from objects, especially painted surfaces.
