

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**  
Remove protective cap. Aim spray at nest. Push button to spray.

For household and industrial use:

**INDOORS: TO KILL WASPS, HORNETS:** Application should be made late in the afternoon or evening. Spray liberally into hiding places under rafters, contacting as many wasps as possible and around nest openings.  
**TO KILL ANTS, COCKROACHES, MITES, SOWBUGS, CRICKETS, CENTIPEDES, AND MILLIPEDES:** Apply insecticide in cracks and crevices, under pipes behind cabinets, and other infested areas until thoroughly wet.  
**TO KILL ANTS:** Spray directly on ant trails, frames, doors, ant trails and hills.  
**TO KILL SPIDERS:** Spray directly on spider applications to the webbing and harbor spiders.

**OUTDOORS:** Apply as a contact spray. Also spray opening away from nest. Do not spray except to spray infested areas.  
**ANTS:** Same as directed above for indoor use. Aim spray at nest openings, eaves, chimneys, cracks and crevices. Contact as many as necessary.

**EARWIGS, SOWBUGS, CRICKETS, CENTIPEDES AND MILLIPEDES:** Indoor use.  
**TO KILL TENT CATERPILLARS:** Apply when caterpillars are young and tents are still being applied in the late afternoon or evening. Returned to their tents. Aim spray to saturate on all sides. Repeat as necessary.
