The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Change "Statement of Practical Treatment" to "First Aid" and modify your eye and skin text to:

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. If irritation persists, get medical attention.

2. Place your "Storage and Disposal" text after the use directions.
3. As indicated on Page 37 of the October 1988 Rotenone Standard, submit a revised copy of your Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF). Your most recent one is dated February 3, 1987. If your product is a repack of another registered product, simply state this fact on the CSF in place of specific values for Blocks 10 to 15.
4. The current name of the registrant, Agrevo Environmental Health, must appear on the label.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

Hazards To Humans & Domestic Animals

WARNING

Pesticide Disposal: FOR CONTAINERS OVER 1 GALLON: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. ON DOGS. DO NOT USE MORE THAN 1 FLUID OUNCE (2 Tbsp) (30 ml) PER GALLON (3.79 L) ON PUPPIES

For fleas and lice, dilute FOLIAFUME Insecticide at the rate of 1 fluid ounce (2 Tbsp) (30 ml) per 1 gallon (3.79 L) of water. For puppies, use 1/2 fluid ounce (1 Tbsp) (15 ml) per 1 gallon (3.79 L) of water. Apply directly to animal as a spray, sponge on or a wash. Dip until animal's skin is wet. Do not inhale.
