### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

**Storage:** This material may stratify upon standing, even at room temperature. Thoroughly mix before each use. Do not expose to temperatures below 40°F (4.5°C). If exposed to temperatures below 40°F (4.45°C), allow to stand until product reaches 80°F (26.5°C) and thoroughly mix before using. DO NOT USE OPEN FLAME FOR WARMING.
