FOR TICKS, dilute UltraTEC Insecticide at the rate of 1 fluid ounce (2 Tbsp)(30 ml) per 1 gallon (3.79 L) of water. For young animals use 1/2 fluid ounce (1 Tbsp)(15 ml) per 1 gallon (3.79 L) of water. Apply directly to animal as a spray, sponge-on or a wash. Dip until animal's skin is wet. Do not rinse.

Avoid contact with eyes, nose or mouTh of animal.

ON CATS: DO NOT USE ON YOUNG KITTENS. ON ADULT ANIMALS, DO NOT USE MORE THAN 1/2 FLUID OUNCE (1 Tbsp)(15 ml) PER GALLON (3.79 L).

FOR FLEAS, TICKS, AND LICE, dilute UltraTEC Insecticide at the rate of 1/2 fluid ounce (1 Tbsp)(15 ml) per gallon (3.79 L) of water. Apply directly to animal as a spray, sponge-on or a wash. Dip until animal's skin is wet. Do not rinse.
