

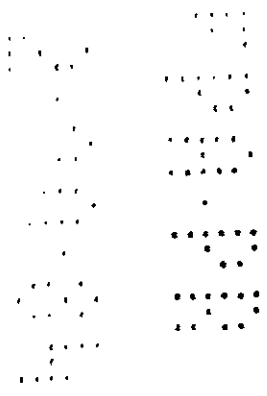

SPACE SPRAY: To Control House Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats (Midges), Wasps, and Small Flying Moths (Millers): Close all doors, windows and ventilators. Direct the spray upward and outward in all directions, filling the room with mist. Keep the area closed for 15 minutes, then thoroughly ventilate before entering the treated area.

TO CONTROL BED BUGS AND MITES IN POULTRY HOUSES: Apply as a crack and crevice/spot treatment to areas where the bed bugs and mites hide, such as cracks in walls and floor, crevices, roost poles and nests.

CONTACT SPRAY: To kill cockroaches (waterbugs), fleas, earwigs, centipedes, sowbugs (pillbugs), boxelder bugs, ants, silverfish (firebrats) and crickets: Direct spray to contact insects in cracks and crevices in floors, baseboards, around pipes, behind cabinets and other harborages. Hit as many insects directly as possible. Apply the spray to the point of run-off. Repeat as necessary.
