Home Garden Use

KILLS COLORADO POTATO BEETLES, APHIDS ON VEGETABLE PLANTS- Mix 3½ tablespoons (1.7 fl.oz.) (50 ml) of PB-NOX with one (1) gallon of water. Spray on vegetables to the point of run-off.
