

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If In Eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention immediately.
If Swallowed: Do not induce vomiting. Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Gastric lavage should be supervised by trained personnel because of the possible pulmonary damage via aspiration of the solvent. Contains xylene. If possible, bring the container and labeling to attending physician.
If On Skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if necessary.
