This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA section 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

- a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 432-756."
- b. The precautionary statement must be revised to read as follows:

Harmful if absorbed through skin or if inhaled. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing and avoid breathing spray. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

Do not use in food/feed areas of food handling establishments, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms, but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. In the home, cover all food handling surfaces and cover or remove all food and cooking utensils, or wash thoroughly after treatment. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

- c. Under the directions for use heading, add the statement:

NOT FOR USE IN USDA MEAT AND POULTRY PLANTS

For use in non-food/non-feed areas indoors and outside premises of hotels, motels, homes, preschools, nurseries, day camps, greenhouses, bathhouses, seed houses, food handling establishments, packaging and processing plants, commercial, industrial, office, institutional and storage buildings, dairies, milk storage rooms, egg processing plants, supermarkets, restaurants, bottling plants, canneries, flour and feed mills, bakeries, and hospitals. In hospitals, patients should be removed prior to treatment.

- d. The statement regarding pets bedding should be revised to read:

Destroy pets old bedding and replace with fresh bedding.

- e. Add the following instructions:

OUTDOOR USE: Do not apply this product to edible crops.

For use around residential, commercial and institutional buildings, patios, mobile homes, campers, boats, and swimming pools for controlling household and other pests.

PESTS ON OUTSIDE SURFACES OF BUILDINGS:
Use this product to control Cockroaches, Crickets, Ants, Millipedes, Earwigs, Spiders and Sowbugs on the outside surface of buildings. To help prevent infestation of buildings, treat the building

foundation to a height of 2 to 3 feet, where pests are active and may find entrance. Also, apply to outside surfaces of building, including porches, screens, window frames, eaves, patios, garages, refuse dumps and other areas where these pests congregate. Apply spray to the point of runoff. Repeat as necessary to maintain effectiveness.

3. In reference to the Confidential Statement of Formula, you must submit the density.

4. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If In Eyes or on skin: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Induce vomiting as first aid for this product may result in increased risk of chemical pneumonia or pulmonary edema caused by aspiration of the hydrocarbon solvent. Vomiting should be induced only under professional supervision.

FLAMMABLE. Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat source, pilot lights or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the label.

DO NOT USE AS A SPACE SPRAY. Spray on surfaces only. Hold container directly nozzle about 12 inches from surface to be treated. Spray away from yourself. Do not allow children or pets in treated area until spray has dried.
REMOVE birds and lightly cover fish bowls and aquariums in areas where you are spraying. Do not use on plants or shrubbery.

Tralex Aerosol may be applied as a general spot and crevice treatment. Examples of non-food areas include: garbage room, lavatories, floors and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler room (after packaging, canning or bottling). All areas that insects inhabit and enter should be treated. Do not use in food processing plants, restaurants, or areas where food is commercially prepared.

TO KILL ROACHES, WATERBUGS, PALMETTO BUGS, SILVERFISH MILLIPEDS: For long lasting action in and around residential and non-residential areas, spray into cracks and crevices and other places where insects enter, such as sinks, cabinets, kitchen appliances, damp areas, window and door frames, shelves, drawers, around plumbing and in attics and crawl spaces. Spray directly on insects if possible. Avoid excessive wetting of linoleum, and treat entire area of floor cover.

TO KILL ANTS, SOWBUGS, AND EARWIGS: Spray around doors and other places where these insects may enter the house. Spray around foundation on ant trails and ant hills and other areas where ants may enter the house.

TO KILL FLEAS: It is suggested that infested area be thoroughly vacuumed. These areas include rugs, carpets, upholstered furniture, pet bedding, resting areas and other indoor areas frequented by pets. The vacuumed material should be discarded in an outdoor trash container immediately. Note: Test portion of furniture or carpet by applying to a small concealed spot, if solution based product should be considered. For long lasting control spray on furniture and floor covering until areas is moist. Treat pet bedding and surface of dog houses. **DO NOT ALLOW PETS TO CONTACT TREATED AREAS UNTIL THEY HAVE DRIED.** Remove or cover animal feed before spraying. To control infestation, pets inhabiting the treated premises should be treated with registered flea application to animals before they reenter the treated area. **WITH THIS PRODUCT.**

TO KILL TICKS (Including Lyme Disease Vectors): Thoroughly spray areas, such as pet beds and resting quarters; nearby cracks and window and door frames, where these pests may be present. For beds, do not allow pets to contact treated areas until spray has dried. Replace bedding with clean bedding after treatment. **DO NOT TREAT PETS.** Do not allow pets to contact treated areas until spray has dried. Respray as needed.
