Subject: Amendment - Update First Aid Statement Deltamethrin Technical Micronized EPA Reg. No. 432-774 Your submission dated September 23, 2003

Dear Mr. Krygsman:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable, subject to the comments listed below.

- 1. This product is in Toxicity Category III for eye irritation. Therefore, add "Causes substantial but temporary eye injury" as the second sentence under the Precautionary Statements section.
- 2. Under the First Aid section, revise the second statement to read "Have the person sip a glass of water if able to swallow." Add the following sentence as the third statement: "Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or a doctor." Correct the spelling of unconscious in the last bullet ("uncious" to "unconscious).
- 3. Delete "Not for Resale Under This Label." This statement is in conflict with the formulators exemption.
