e. Revise the effluent discharge labeling statement in accordance with PR Notice 93-10

The two Alternate Confidential Statements of Formula (Alt.CSFs) dated 6/25/93 and 10/7/93 are acceptable, however all Alt.CSFs should be numbered as Alt. #1 etc.

The dermal sensitization study is rated Supplementary and the category assigned will be a positive sensitizer. The reason for this decision is based on the positive results of the sensitization study on "Tetraperm Wasp & Hornet Killer FEQ24". The only difference in the two test substances is the percentage of mineral oil solvent, with the FEQ24 product having a lower concentration of active ingredients. The FEQ24 may be a false positive, and the OB Concentrate study may be correct, but the following information/data is lacking: 1. Test method was not defined, 2. Acclimation period for test animals should be specified. 3. Challenge concentrations for both test material and positive control should be given. 4. Screening data was not provided. Thus, without the missing data, we are unable to make a determination. You, therefore have a choice to either submit the missing information for review or accept the positive dermal sensitization category for labeling purposes

3. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6 (e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label and a copy of the acute toxicity review are enclosed for your records.
