- d. Under step 1 and 2 delete "shut off electrical appliances" and "Do not place can within 6 feet of pilot lights" and replace the bullets under "Important To Avoid Flammability Hazards" with the following statement:

"Do not use more than one fogger per room. Do not use in small, enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets or under counters or table. Do not use in room 5 ft. x 5 ft. or small; instead, allow fog to enter from other rooms. Turn off all ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valve), other open flames or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e., refrigerators, thermostats, etc.). Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance."

3. The alternate confidential statement of formula dated October 25, 1995 is acceptable.

4. Submit three (3) copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6 (e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labelling.

One 6 ounce aerosol can treats up to 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area (a room 30' x 25' with an 8 foot ceiling).

ALTERNATE USE DIRECTIONS

One 4 ounce aerosol can treats up to 4,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area (a room 20' x 25' with an 8' ceiling).

OR

One 3 ounce aerosol can treats up to 3,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area (a room 18.5' x 20' with an 8' ceiling).

For Fleas and Ticks, use one 6 ounce fo: every 6,000 cubic feet of room space.

Do not use in food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food/feed is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas

where foods may be prepared or held. In the home all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use.

For use in nonfood/nonfeed areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

Not for use in USDA meat and poultry plants.

HOW TO USE:

Step 1: PREPARATION

Open cupboards, cabinets, trunks, and doors to area to be treated to allow maximum kill in all areas where insects can hide and breed. Close outside doors and windows and shut off fans and air conditioning to maximize killing power of fog. Remove pets, birds, and tightly cover or remove fish bowls and aquariums before spraying. Cover waxed wood floors and waxed furniture in the immediate area surrounding the fogger (newspapers may be used). Remove or cover exposed foods, dishes, utensils or food handling equipment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. Shut off electrical appliances. Do not place activated fogger in a cabinet or under a counter or table.

Step 2: ACTIVATION OF FOGGER

SHAKE WELL JUST BEFORE USING. Place a section of newspaper on floor in center of room to be treated.

NOTE: Do not place fogger on water-stainable surface. Do not place can within 6 feet of pilot lights. Tilt can opening away from face and depress tab firmly with thumb until it clicks in locked position. Aiming spray away from face, set fogger on newspaper, leave room and close door. After activation, leave room or house at once.

Keep area closed for 2 hours (30 minutes for flying insects) before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

IMPORTANT! To avoid **FLAMMABILITY HAZARD**, use can as follows:

- ‡ Only one can per room.
- ‡ Do not place in cabinet or under counter or table.
- ‡ Shut off electrical equipment.
- ‡ Place can at least 6 feet from pilot lights.
