

DIRECTIONS FOR USE


It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TO USE: Carefully remove one mat from its packaging and slide onto the metal heater plate. Light burner by placing lighted match or lighter to wick of burner until wick has lighted. Place lamp in the area to be protected. Lamp should be placed on a flat, level surface. For best results, use in confined areas such as decks, porches, yards and similar locations with still or gently moving air. Lamps will protect an area of approximately 10 x 10 ft. When larger areas require protection, additional lamps should be used. The blue indicator color in the mat gradually turns white with use showing that the mat has been used up. Then replace old mat with a new mat.

NOTE: Avoid placing opened mats on light-colored surfaces to ensure against staining.

ALTERNATE DIRECTIONS

Remove mat from [protective] [foil] packaging and place [slide] [into slot provided] [under grill] onto the [metal] [ceramic] heater plate [mat holder] [over heat source]. [Plug into an electrical outlet and] Place heater unit in the area to be protected. For best results, use in confined areas such as decks, porches, yards and similar locations with still or gently moving air. One unit [mat] will protect an area of approximately 10 x 10 ft. When larger areas require protection, additional heater units should be used. Each mat gives a maximum of 4 hours of protection. [Mat may be left in place and used repeatedly for a total of 4 hours per mat.] The blue indicator color in the mat gradually turns white with use showing that the mat has been used up. Exchange [replace] old mat with a new mat [Slip in a fresh mat pushing out the old mat with the new one.] [For optimum results, activate mat 15 to 20 minutes before protections is required.]

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Storage: Store unopened mats in a cool, dry place, out of reach of children. Do not store partly used mats.

Disposal: Wrap used and partially used mats and discard in trash. Do not re-use spent mats.
