IN MUSHROOM PRODUCTION AND PROCESSING:

To control flying insects, such as mushroom flies and fungus gnats in growing houses, apply at a rate of 1 ounce per 1000 cubic feet of space. Fogger should be operated 8 to 10 feet away from beds and directed slightly upward over them. Circulating fans should be left in operation, but for best results, refrigerators should be turned off. In packing and canning plants, use at a rate of 1 ounce to 2000 cubic feet of space.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage and Spill Procedures: Store upright at room temperature. In case of spill or leakage, soak up with an absorbent material such as

sand, sawdust, earth, fuller's earth, etc. Dispose of with chemical waste.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide, spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal: Triple rinse (or equivalent) then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other approved State and local procedures.
