and original submission dated May 20, 1999

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA section 3(c)(7)(a), is acceptable provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data or other material required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) or FIFRA section 4 when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a) Under the product name, correct the spelling of "FORMULATION".
 - b) Be sure to show the new EPA Reg No. 432-1108 instead of 4816-640.
 - c) In the FIRST AID section, revise the IF SWALLOWED advice to read as follows: "Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person. Avoid alcohol."
 - d) In the FIRST AID section, revise the IF ON SKIN advice to read as follows: "Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected skin promptly with soap and water. Get medical attention."

- e) In the First Aid section, revise the IF IN EYES advice to read As follows: "Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately."
 - f) Replace the first sentence of the Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals with the following two sentences: "Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye injury." Also, expand "Wash thoroughly after handling." to read "Wash thoroughly after handling and before smoking or eating."
3. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
