Compatibility studies with other pesticides, fertilizers, and other biologically active materials have not been completed. Do not apply in combination with other materials.

No phytotoxic response on any turfgrass species has been observed to date.

Make application with broadcast equipment capable of applying 1.5 - 15.0 pounds of product per acre. Calibrate and adjust equipment prior to application to ensure that the proper rate of product will be applied.
