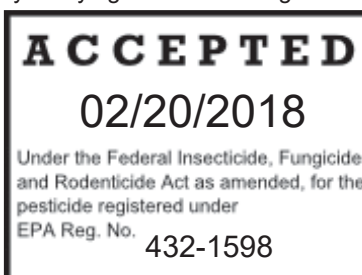

Repeat this procedure two more times. Then for Plastic Container, offer for recycling if available or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration. Do not burn, unless allowed by state and local ordinances.
