Directions For Use

SUPER FLY SHY is designed primarily for use as a spray to protect dairy and beef cattle and from attacks of biting flies in pasture. It is also a very effective space spray and will provide fast knock down and kill flies, mosquitoes and gnats.

SUPER FLY SHY is to be used in the milk room as well as in the barn.


SPACE SPRAY FOR BARN AND MILK ROOM

To clear enclosed areas of flies, mosquitoes and gnats, spray towards the ceiling and corners until the area is filled with a light mist. For best results, close up all windows and doors during the spraying and keep them closed for 10 to 20 minutes after spraying. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat as necessary.

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Do not spray on or near open flame. Store in cool place. Keep container tightly closed. Store out of reach of children. Avoid contamination of milk and milk handling equipment. Avoid overspraying, which will result in wetting the animal's hide.

Directions For Use

Kills and repels horn flies, stable flies, mosquitoes and gnats. When properly applied, the repellent effect against above insects will last 2 days or 48 hours.

DAIRY COWS -- BEEF CATTLE

To develop a residual repellency to stable flies, horn flies, mosquitoes and gnats on dairy cows and beef cattle, apply 2 to 2 ounces of SUPER FLY SHY to each animal for a 3 day period. SUPER FLY SHY should be applied with a good sprayer so that the entire animal's body has been uniformly covered. Special care should be used in spraying the legs, belly and shoulders. Avoid areas around nose, eyes and mouth. Avoid wetting the hide. Spray in the same manner again after 2 days have elapsed and every second day thereafter or when insects again disturb the animal. Be sure the teats and udder are washed with warm water prior to milking.

CALVES

Calves should be sprayed very lightly once a day instead of attempting to build up a residual repellency by spraying more heavily.

FACE FLIES

Apply SUPER FLY SHY on the face of cattle at the rate of 1.0 fl. oz. per animal, paying particular attention to the areas near the eyes and nostrils. Wipe on with a heavy cloth or sponge, or spray on with a sprayer that delivers coarse droplets. Avoid spraying directly into the animal's eyes. Treatment should be made daily while the cattle are stanchioned for morning milking to give protection from face flies for 24 hours.

OTHER LIVESTOCK

To develop a residual repellency to stable flies, horn flies, mosquitoes and gnats on livestock, spray SUPER FLY SHY as indicated above and also to protect them from attacks by fleas, spray bedding and walls of pen, particularly cracks and crevices. Repeat treatment frequently until adequate control is obtained.

LICE ON LIVESTOCK

For control of lice on livestock, spray the animal with 2 ounces of SUPER FLY SHY. Immediately rub the spray into the hair, paying particular attention to the infested areas. Repeat as necessary, but not more frequently than once every 3 weeks.

ROACH KILLER

To use as roach killer, SUPER FLY SHY should be applied on the surface desired for protection to the point that the spray is about to run off the surface. Treatment of cracks and crevices should also be made.

In a complete fly control program these sprays should be used in combination with residual insecticides and sanitary measures.
