**FEEDING DIRECTIONS**

**MIX WITH SALT**

Mix Standard's Beef Mineral Premix Medicated with salt, equal parts by weight and feed at the daily rate of .15 oz. per 100 lb. of body weight. The following may be used as a guide.

Wt. of Animal	Daily Requirements
500 lbs.	3/4 oz.
750 lbs.	1-1/8 oz.
1000 lbs.	1-1/2 oz.

When feeding the above mixture, all additional salt and mineral should be removed.

**MIXING WITH SALT AND VITAMINS**

Standard's Beef Mineral Premix Medicated may be mixed with vitamin products in addition to salt as follows:

**SUPER NUTRO or FEEDING COMPOUND**

1/3 part Beef Mineral Premix Medicated  
 1/3 part Super Nutro Complex or Vitamin Feeding Compound  
 1/3 part salt  
 1000 lb. animal should consume .225 oz. per 100 lbs. body weight or 2 1/4 oz. per day.

**BO-VITA**

1/4 part Beef Mineral Premix Medicated  
 1/4 part salt  
 1/2 part Bo-Vita  
 1000 lb. animal should consume 3 oz. per day.

**MIXING WITH FEEDS AND SUPPLEMENTS**

You may mix Standard's Beef Mineral Medicated, undiluted with feeds and supplements at the rate to which will supply 3/4 oz. daily for a 1000 lb. animal. The following may be used as a guide. Additional salt and vitamins should be supplied as required.

Daily Feed Consumption	Beef Mineral Premix Med. Added per Ton
10 lbs.	9-2/5 lbs.
15 lbs.	7 lbs.
20 lbs.	4-7/10 lbs.
Daily Supplement Consumption	Beef Mineral Premix Med. Added per Ton
1 lb.	94 lbs.
1-1/2 lbs.	70 lbs.
2 lbs.	47 lbs.

If consumption is excessive, add salt to reduce intake. If consumption is below the recommended level, ground grains, protein supplement or dried molasses should be added to increase consumption.

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
