FEEDING DIRECTIONS

750 lb. animals: requires 1 1/3 ounces per head per day.
 1000 lb. animals: requires 1 3/4 ounces per head per day.

Feed 0.175 ounces of STANDARD'S SUMMER MINERAL MEDICATED per day for each 100 lbs. of body weight. This product may be fed free choice or mixed in mineral free feed or a mineral free supplement at the above recommended rate. Be sure ample bunk space is available. Locate the STANDARD'S SUMMER MINERAL MEDICATED near the animals water, or near their loafing area. Keep plenty of mineral available. If bunks or feeders are empty do not expect to maintain control of fly breeding.

Do not feed any other salt or mineral. STANDARD'S SUMMER MINERAL MEDICATED has been thoroughly tested against the horn fly and face fly and will prevent the breeding of an average of 90% or more of the horn flies and 70% or more of the face flies in the manure of treated cattle, when used as directed.

For maximum protection against horn flies and face flies, cattle should be sprayed at the start of the fly season, and fed STANDARD'S SUMMER MINERAL MEDICATED continuously, beginning several weeks before the fly season until all adult horn flies and face flies have disappeared in the fall. STANDARD'S SUMMER MINERAL MEDICATED prevents the breeding of horn flies and face flies in the manure of treated cattle, but does not affect any existing adult flies. Adult face flies migrate considerable distance, therefore area-wide control should be practiced whenever possible.

STANDARD'S SUMMER MINERAL MEDICATED is excellent for self-feeding in a mineral feeder with Standard's Vitamin Pre-mixes.
