DIRECTIONS FOR LAUNDRY USE

Use Stachlor Bleach with any good laundry detergent or soap. Stachlor bleaches, removes stains, deodorizes and disinfects.

MACHINE LAUNDRING: In top loading automatics and wringer washers, use 1 cup STACHLOR per load. For front loading washers, use ½ cup per load. STACHLOR SHOULD BE ADDED TO WASH WATER BEFORE LAUNDRY.

HAND LAUNDRING: Use 1 tablespoonful STACHLOR per gallon of water. Add STACHLOR to water before adding garments.

STAIN REMOVAL: Stains caused by Fruit, Vegetables, Grass, Coffee, Tea, Chocolate, Wine, Many Inks, and Medicines, plus Mildew and Scorch; use ½ cup of STACHLOR per gallon of hot water. Before laundering, soak entire stained item in the solution for 5 minutes. Rinse well, and repeat if necessary. USE COOL WATER SOLUTION FOR STAINS THAT CAN BE SET BY HOT WATER, EX: EGG, MILK, OR BLOOD, COLORED OR DELICATE FABRICS.

NYLON FABRICS YELLOWED WITH AGE: Soak 20 to 30 minutes in solution of 2 tablespoonsful per 1 gallon of water and tablespoonful of household vinegar. Rinse, repeat if necessary.

BLEACH TEST: Before using STACHLOR on colors, or special finishes, test for color fastness by soaking an inconspicuous portion of the fabric, for 5 minutes in a solution of 1 tablespoonful STACHLOR in 1 gallon of hot, sudsy water.

STACHLOR TO REMOVE STAINS: Refrigerator Plastic, Metal, with a solution of 1 quart of STACHLOR. Do not use on glass. After glassware, use 1 cup STACHLOR in 10-15 min. CLEANER. SICKROOMS: remove stains with solution of hot water. TO PREVENT mold against bacteria. STACHLOR before disinfecting. SEPTIC TANKS: USE OF STACHLOR
