

DESCRIPTION

The presence of algae in outdoor swimming pools is objectionable because of the color, cloudiness, odor, and increased chlorine demand of the water. The use of STACO ALGAECIDE will help to maintain the water in a clean condition. STACO ALGAECIDE is compatible with the usual water treatment chemicals. By controlling algae growth with STACO ALGAECIDE, the chlorine demand of the pool may be significantly reduced.

DANGER:

Keep out of reach of children. Avoid contact with eyes, nose, mouth, and skin. If contact occurs, wash thoroughly with water. If swallowed, drink plenty of water and seek medical attention.

FIRST AID:

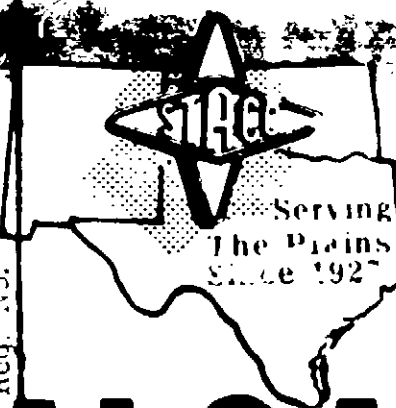

DIRECTIONS

1. In freshly filled pools or pools showing no visible algae growth, add one gallon of STACO ALGAECIDE per 50,000 gallons of water to prevent algae growth. This will give 2 parts per million (PPM) of Quaternary Ammonium Compound. Apply this product to the pool by adding to the swimmer or by spraying around the pool.
2. If algae growth is observed, add one gallon of STACO ALGAECIDE for each 20,000 gallons of water to kill and control these algae species most commonly found in swimming pools. Once the STACO ALGAECIDE is added, the water will turn a light blue color. After 24 hours, the water should be clear. If the water is still cloudy, add more STACO ALGAECIDE. The water should be clear within 48 hours. If the water is still cloudy, the pool may require more treatment.
3. If the pool water is cloudy, add one gallon of STACO ALGAECIDE per 20,000 gallons of water. If the water is still cloudy after 24 hours, add another gallon. The water should be clear within 48 hours. If the water is still cloudy, the pool may require more treatment.
