

Application for re-registration for Label for Durham's Carbon Disulfide (430-35)
Submitted by Durham's Drug Products Company, Comanche, Texas.

CARBON DISULFIDE

(Hi-Lite)

DIRECTIONS: For fumigating grains, seal the bin or room as tightly as possible and pour the Carbon Disulfide on top of the grain or place in shallow pans on top of the grain at the rate of 10 to 20 lbs. of Carbon Disulfide per 1000 cubic feet of air space or 2 pints of the product per 250 cubic feet of air-tight containers.

If grain filled bins are not tight 3 gallons of Disulfide of Carbon should be used for each 1000 cubic feet of air space.

ANTIDOTE: If Inhaled—get victim into fresh air immediately and give artificial respiration if breathing has stopped. Call a physician immediately.

If Swallowed—Give one-half cupful of medicinal mineral oil. Give large quantities of warm water. Give hot tea or coffee. Call a physician immediately.

DANGER: Extremely Flammable! Keep away from fire, sparks or heated surfaces. Store in a cool place. Keep container tightly closed. Do not inhale or breathe vapor. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing.
