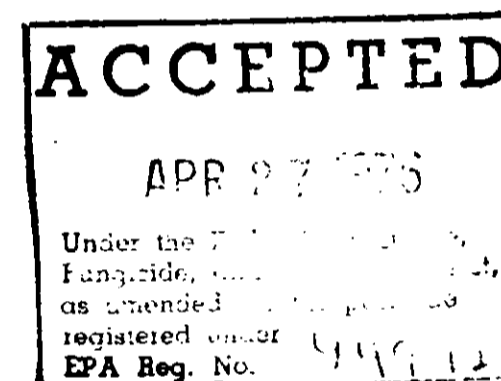

Soil Insects in Corn: For the control of cutworms until August 1, 1976.

Broadcast Application - (Just prior to and up to 14 days before planting)
Mix 2 quarts of Heptachlor 3E in sufficient water to cover one acre. Apply broadcast with a field sprayer to the soil.

DISC IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE SPRAY IS APPLIED.

Band Application - Use 1-1/3 quarts of Heptachlor 3E per acre. Mix with sufficient water to cover an acre and use a field sprayer to apply directly in the row behind planter at time of planting.

IMPORTANT: The amount of water used per acre will vary with available equipment and its calibration. For successful application, make sure sprayer is thoroughly clean and calibrated correctly as to nozzle size, pressure and ground speed before spraying operations begin.

WARNING: Hazardous if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through skin! In case of contact, immediately remove contaminated clothing and flush skin or eyes with plenty of water; for eyes, get medical attention and flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking; wear clean clothing. If material is to be handled, wear clean synthetic rubber gloves and mask or respirator of a type passed by the U. S. Department of Agriculture for Heptachlor protection. Keep away from children and domestic animals. Do not apply to areas occupied by unprotected humans or beneficial animals. Do not contaminate feed and

foodstuffs. Do not breathe vapor or spray mist. Do not get on skin. Birds feeding on dying insects may be harmed.

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Keep out of lakes, ponds, and streams. Do not apply in any manner not specified on the label. Rinse equipment and containers and dispose of wastes by burying in non-crop lands away from water supplies. Containers should be disposed by punching holes in them and burying with wastes, or by burning. (Keep out of smoke.)
