

## USE AND DIRECTIONS FOR APPLICATIONS

### APPLICATION TO LACTATING AND NON-LACTATING DAIRY CATTLE AND BEEF CATTLE

Use at the rate of 2 1/2 ounces daily. Two applications of 1 pound morning and 1 pound at night are recommended. May be applied as a mist spray with an automatic sprayer. Spray to thoroughly cover all parts of the animal including legs, but do not wet the skin. Do not apply more than 2 1/2 ounces per animal per day. Do not apply regularly to calves under 6 months of age. Brahman cattle should not be treated as they may show hypersensitivity to organic phosphates.

### AS A SPACE SPRAY IN DAIRY BARN AND LOAFING SHEDS

To control flies, gnats and mosquitoes, apply as a fog or mist. 1 pint of 4% solution will treat 8,000 cubic feet (40x20x10).

Before applying reduce air movement as much as possible by closing doors, windows and other openings. Do not use this solution for fogging or misting purposes in areas where animals have received a direct application within 8 hours. Remove dairy animals from dairy barn or loafing shed prior to application of space spray.


