**STRAWBERRIES:** For new plantings, apply five tablespoons of WEED-D as a broadcast soil application in sufficient water to cover 100 square feet at transplanting. For established plantings apply three and one-half to five tablespoons as a broadcast application in sufficient water to cover 100 square feet in the fall or early spring. Do not apply after first bloom.

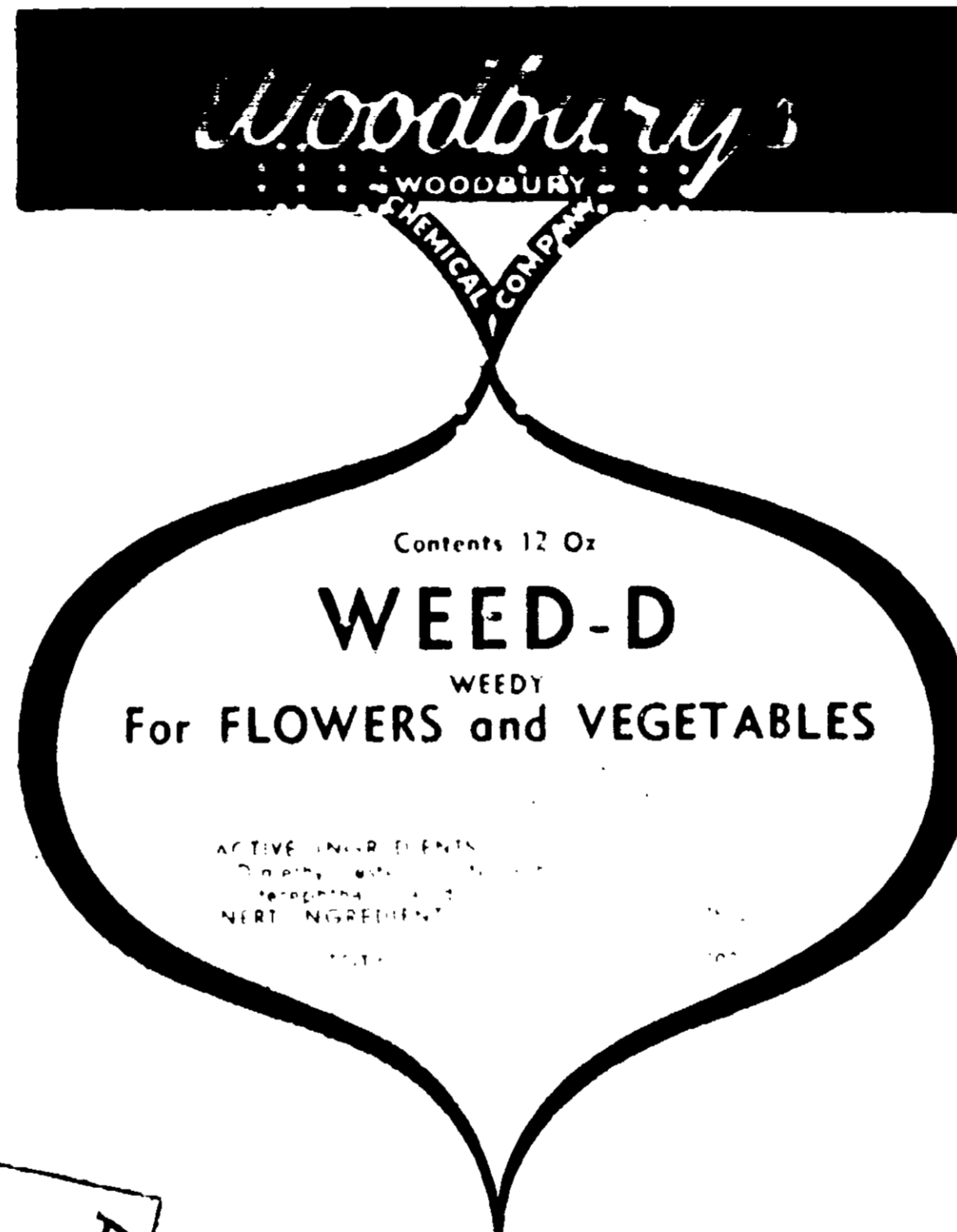
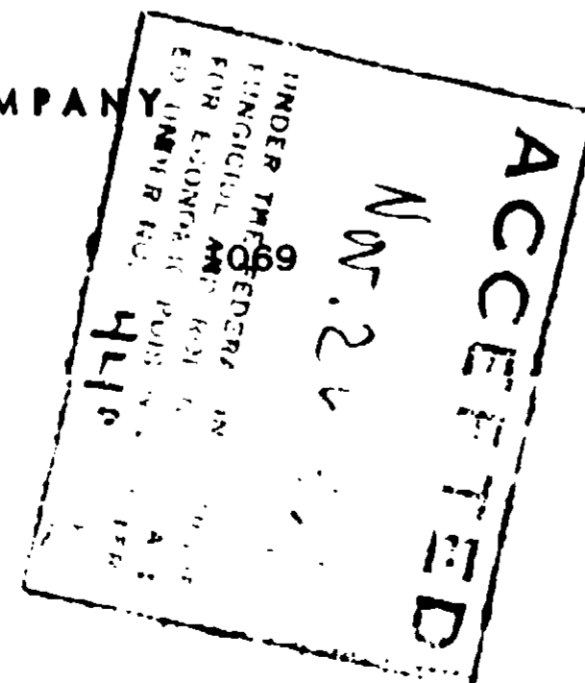
**VEGETABLES: SEEDED—**Broccoli, Cabbage, Cauliflower, Onions, Snap Beans; **TRANSPLANTED—**Broccoli, Cabbage, Cauliflower, Onions, Sweet Potatoes, Tomatoes, Strawberries.

**CONTROLS THESE WEEDS:** Carpetweed, Common Chickweed, Purslane, Hairy Crabgrass, Goose Grass, Green Foxtail, Yellow Foxtail, Spotted Spurge, Prostrate Spurge, Spiny Pigweed, Dodder and others.

**VEGETABLE CROPS:** Apply five tablespoons of WEED-D in sufficient water to cover 100 square feet. Application of WEED-D should be made to the soil surface along with or directly following seeding. When transplanting, apply either immediately after transplanting or some time prior to the germination and emergence of susceptible weed species. For tomatoes spray overall four to six weeks after transplanting to weed-free soil.

**LAWNS:** Apply to established lawns at 6 tablespoons in sufficient water to cover 100 sq. ft. before germination of weedy grass seeds. Use sprinkler thoroughly to carry WEED-D into the soil. Do not apply to newly seeded grass.

**TRANSPLANTS:** Apply uniformly at the rate of five to six tablespoons in sufficient water to cover 100 sq. ft. Apply overall at time of transplanting for new plantings and in the fall or early spring for established plantings.

**WEED-D** is specifically recommended for weed control with the following: Azalea, Barbary, Euonymus, Forsythia, Japanese Andromeda, Juniper, Lantana, Pachistima, Pine, Rose, Tree Peony, Variegated Privet, Wilson Ivy, Yew, Ageratum, Alyssum, Aster, Babysbreath, Bleeding Heart, Chrysanthemum, Candy Tuft, Celosia, Columbine, Coral Bells, Dahlia, Evening Primrose, Fern Leaf Yarrow, Feverfew, Forget-me-not, Gladiolus, Golden Marguerite, Golden Tuft, Impatiens, Morning Glory, Mourning Bride, Mourning Pinks, Petunia, Poker Plant, Purple Leafed Hydrangea, Rose Hips, Sahris Scarlet Sage, Snapdragon, Verbena, Zinnia.
