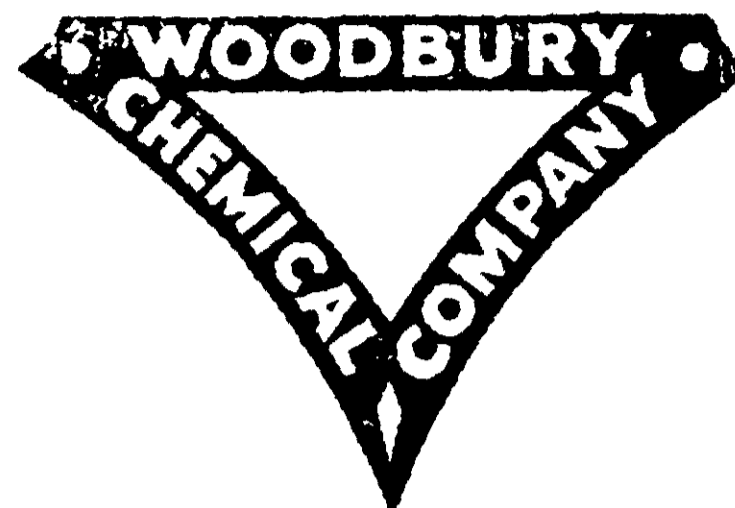

DIRECTIONS

ORNAMENTAL FLOWERS AND SHRUBS — Against aphids and spider mites apply as needed for good coverage or at 25 to 30 pounds per acre in nursery plantings. Make a complete application of all parts and foliage.

FLEAS — On cats and dogs. Apply with a shaker top can to treat the animals thoroughly. Repeat every two or three weeks if necessary. In kennels, yards, lawns or under shrubs and under house apply one to two pounds per 1,000 square feet of area with a duster or by sifting from a burlap bag. Remove manure or debris before dusting. Do not treat animals under 1 month of age.
