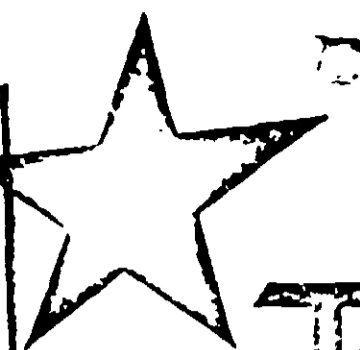

AG CHLORDANE 25G

FOR CONTROL OF SOIL INSECTS IN CORN (Field and Sweet)

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:

Technical Chlordane* 25%

INERT INGREDIENT: 75%

TOTAL 100%

*Equivalent to 15% Octachloro-4, 7-methanotetrahydroindane and 10% Related Compounds.

CAUTION

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed; contact with skin can cause toxic symptoms. Avoid breathing of dust. In case of contact with skin, wash with soap and water. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Keep out of lakes, ponds and streams. Do not apply to any area not specified on the label. Do not apply in any manner not specified on the label. ANTIDOTE: External — In case of spillage on skin, wash promptly with soap and water.
Internal — Emetic of 1 tablespoonful mustard in tumbler of water. Call physician.

DIRECTIONS: BROADCAST APPLICATIONS:

Make broadcast application of 10 - 16 pounds of AG Chlordane 25G per acre for control of:

- 1) White grubs: For use in Michigan only.
- 2) Japanese Beetle: For use only in Federal/State quarantine programs.
(To include treatments required to certify to pest free conditions as well as for use in suppression and control programs.)
- 3) White Fringed Beetle: For control of white fringed beetle attacking food crops in 8 S. E. states (AL, FL, GA, LA, MS, NC, SC, TN).
- 4) Cutworms on corn: Use continued only until August 1, 1976.

Apply AG Chlordane 25G after the field is plowed. Disk in promptly. Use the higher rate on heavier soils and the lower rate on light sandy soils. Use the higher rates for heavy and late planting of corn.

Consult your Extension Service or county agent for detailed recommendations.
