DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Application should be made only by experienced personnel using proper safety equipment. Apply with a combination drill or fertilizer spreader or aircraft to cover soil uniformly. Cultivate immediately to mix the insecticide into top 3 to 6 inches of soil.

Keep all persons and animals out of treated areas for 48 hours. See below for additional cautions.

**ISH POTATOES:** For wireworms, use 60 to 80 pounds per acre broadcast for even coverage of the soil surface before planting and thoroughly work into the upper 4 inches of soil.

**WARNING:** Poisonous if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. **RAPIDLY ABSORBED THROUGH SKIN!** Do not contaminate feed and foodstuffs. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear a mask or respirator of a type passed by the U. S. Department of Agriculture for Parathion protection. A half mask equipped with cartridges that will absorb organic vapors, supplemented with aerosol filters should be worn at all times while the operator is exposed to mists containing Parathion.

When used constantly during the day, the filters must be changed several times. Keep all persons out of the operating area or vicinity where there may be danger of drift. Vacated areas should not be re-entered until the drifting insecticides and volatile residues have dissipated. Only persons experienced in handling hazardous insecticides should make application.

Wear clean natural rubber gloves, protective clothing and goggles while using this product. Do not get on skin, in eyes or on clothing. Do not breathe spray or mist. Do not take into mouth. If spilled on skin, wash immediately with soap and warm water. Wash hands, arms and face after handling and before eating or smoking. Clothing that has become contaminated should be removed immediately and thoroughly washed with soap and water.

**ANTIDOTE AND FIRST AID TREATMENT:** Persons who show any contraction of eye pupils, or have headaches, nausea or other signs of illness while or soon after handling Parathion must be taken to a doctor at once. The physician should be informed that repeated treatment with atropine, to the limit of the patient's tolerance, is the most effective antidote. **CALL A PHYSICIAN AT ONCE!**

**SKIN:** Wash immediately with plenty of soap and water. Remove all contaminated clothing and wash before re-use.

**EYES:** Flush immediately with large amounts of water.

**INTERNAL:** If swallowed, immediately induce vomiting (finger down throat) or administer a tablespoonful of salt in a glass of warm water and repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Have victim lie down and keep quiet.

This product is poisonous to fish and wildlife. Keep out of lakes, ponds and streams. Do not apply in any manner not specified on the label. Destroy empty container by burying or burning in a safe place. Keep out of smoke and fumes.
