COMMERCIAL WOOD PRESERVATION This product is suitable for commercial wood preservation to control against termites, wood destroying insects and decay fungi. This product is a 5% Pentachlorophenol solution in an AWWA P9 Type A Solvent, suitable for pressure or thermal treatment according to practices generally outlined in Commodity Standard of the American Wood Preservers' Association (AWPA) and Federal Specifications TT-W 570 and TT-W 571. These practices include conditioning the wood by air seasoning, kiln drying, steaming or boiling prior to treatment, followed by treatment in hot and cold baths of solution (thermal process) or pressure processes generally known as empty cell (Rueping or Lowry) treatment. The pressures, temperatures, times, minimum retentions and penetrations are specified by AWWA Commodity Standards.

WOOD PRESERVATION For best results this product should be applied so as to effect maximum penetration into the wood joints, especially at joints and wherever end grain exists. Open tank treatment or complete immersion of the wood in the solution is generally recommended for five minutes per inch of thickness. It should be noted that wood treated for use in contact with ground, such as fence posts, will need maximum protection. Extend the treating time 12 to 48 hours. If they cannot be dipped, apply several heavy brush coats. Fence posts to be properly treated should be free of bark, dry and well seasoned.

For protection of wood against termites, powder post beetles and decay treatment of wood prior to use is always recommended. Obtaining commercially pressure treated wood is the best assurance of thorough treatment, but immersion to get deep penetration and distribution of the preservative can impart a very measurable degree of protection.

Where such treating is impractical as in the case of an existing structure, two heavy brush applications of this product should be applied, cut out and removing all unsound wood two feet beyond any visible evidence of decay.

All wood should be cut, squared and the framing or cutting completed before treatment.

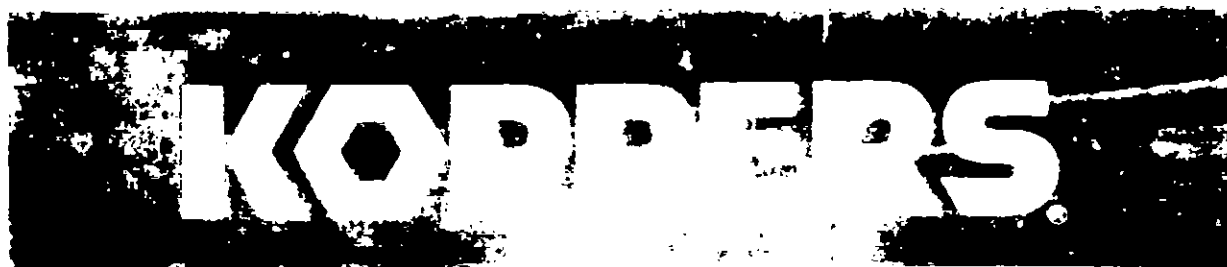
PROHIBITIONS Do not contaminate water, food, or feed with storage or disposal.

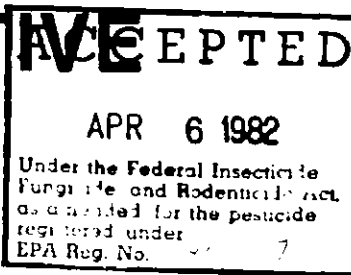
