DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Stir well until the contents have the same consistency. Before treating poles, remove all algae by hand.

With a brush, apply treatment to the surface of the pole with a coating of 1/4 inch to 1/2 inch and then brush the area of the pole in a total of 30 to 24 inches in length. The brush should be used to cover the treated area with a light coating of the product to increase the effectiveness of the treatment.

This product meets the requirements of Part 151.10 of which meet Federal Standards II Water Quality Criteria for the Aquatic Insecticide and Fungicide. The product is registered under EPA Registration P 9 for a heavy petroleum solvent.

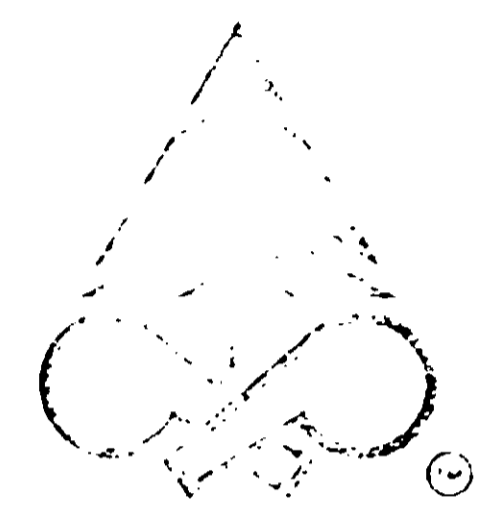

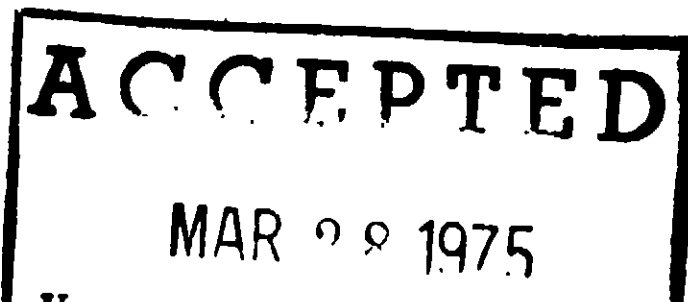

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Before treating a pole, remove all decayed wood. Apply a coating a minimum of 1/2 inch thick around the ground line area of the pole in a band 18 to 24 inches wide extending 2 to 6 inches above the ground line. Cover the treated area with a suitable plastic paper to increase the effectiveness of the treatment.

This Product contains 10.18% Technical Pentachlorophenol which meets Federal Specification TT-W-57 and American Wood Preservers' Association Specification P-6. The solvent system meets the AWP specification P-5 for a heavy grade solvent.

This product is a ready-to-use, penetrating preservative coating designed for the groundline treatment of standing poles and for the treatment of the groundline area of poles in the yard that will be relocated or that have been in storage for prolonged periods. This product is also useful for the treatment of piling cut-offs.

Standing Poles: Use this product only on poles as inspected by qualified inspector to be satisfactory for continued service. Dig a trench around the pole to the depth determined by the inspector to be necessary for the application of the preservative treatment. This may vary from 12 inches in wet areas to 18 inches or more in arid regions. Scrape away dirt and decayed wood from pole surface. With a brush, paddle, squeegee or mechanical applicator apply a coating a minimum of 1/2 inch thick from the bottom of the trench to a predetermined height—2 inches to 2 feet—above ground line to suit local conditions. Cover the treated area with a suitable plastic or tarp material to increase the effectiveness of the treatment. Store this product in a suitable, weather-resistant container. Seal this wrap-up with a suitable fastener, filling the trench with soil.

Relocated Poles: Use this product on poles that are to be relocated. Treat the groundline area of the pole to be relocated with this product. Seal the wrap-up with a suitable fastener.

Piling Cut-Offs: Treat the groundline with this product. Seal the wrap-up with a suitable fastener.

Yard Poles: Use this product on poles in the yard that are to be relocated. Treat the groundline area of the pole to be relocated with this product. Seal the wrap-up with a suitable fastener.
