Stir well until entire contents have the same consistency. Before treating poles, remove all decayed wood. With a brush, trowel, gun or other suitable device, apply a coating of 1/4 inch thick around the ground line area of the pole in a band 18 to 24 inches wide, extending 2 to 6 inches above the ground line. Cover the treated area with a suitable plastic coated paper to increase the effectiveness of the treatment.

This product contains 10.18% Technical Pentachlorophenol which meets Federal Specification TT-W-570 and American Wood-Preservers' Association Specification P-8. The solvent system meets the AWPA Specification P-9 for a heavy petroleum solvent.

- Keep from freezing.
- Always stir contents well before using.
- If product becomes oily, stir well and then stir in water sparingly to restore the product to its original creaminess. Do not add more water than is necessary. Generally only a few ounces of water will be needed for a 5-gallon bucket of this product.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

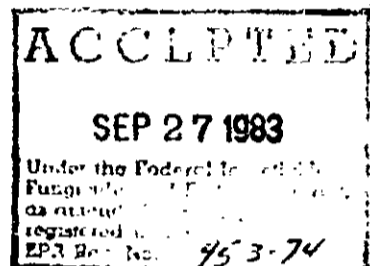

WARNING
