SAPSTAIN CONTROL CHEMICAL

SUPER DIPRITE is a fungicide recommended for the control of sapstain and mold that degrade lumber and poles, posts and other forest products during the seasoning period. This product has an excess of alkalinity so that it is generally unnecessary to add soda ash or similar alkaline materials when dipping oak.

For use under normal seasoning weather conditions, use 10 pounds of SUPER DIPRITE per 100 U.S. gallons of water on lumber 2 inches or less in thickness, making sure the lumber is completely submerged in the dip solution.

For use during rainy seasons or under conditions where seasoning takes place very slowly and for the treatment of heavy timber by dip or spray, use double strength (20 pounds per 100 gallons of water).

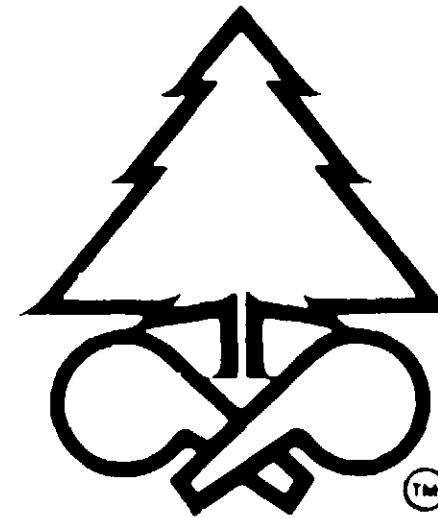
