DIRECTIONS FOR USE

COMMERCIAL WOOD PRESERVATION: This product is suitable for commercial wood preservation to control against termites, powder post beetles and decay fungi. This product is a Water Repellent 5% Pentachlorophenol solution in an AWPAP9, Type C Solvent, suitable for pressure treatment according to practices generally outlined in Commodity Standards of the American Wood-Preservers' Association (AWPA) and Federal Specifications TT-W-570 and TT-W-571. These practices include conditioning the wood by air seasoning, kiln drying, steaming or Boulton drying prior to treatment by pressure processes generally known as empty cell (Rueping or Lowry) treatment. The pressures, temperatures, times, minimum retentions and penetrations are specified by AWPA Commodity Standards.

WOOD PRESERVATION: For best results this product should be applied so as to effect maximum penetration into the wood and absorption especially at joints and wherever end grain exists. Open tank treatment or complete immersion of the wood in the solution is generally recommended for five minutes per inch of thickness. It should be noted that wood items for use in contact with ground, such as fence posts, will need maximum protection. Extend the treating time 12 to 48 hours. If they cannot be dropped, apply several heavy brush coats. Fence posts to be properly treated should be free of bark, dry and well seasoned.

For the protection of wood against termites, powder post beetles and decay the treatment of wood prior to use is always to be recommended. Treating commercially pressure treated wood is the best assurance of thorough treatment, but immersion to get deep penetration and distribution of the preservative can improve protection.
