WOOD PRESERVATION:

Fence posts, poles, foundation timbers and heavy wooden members should be free of bark, dry, and well seasoned and immersed in the product for a period of 12 to 48 hours to be an effective wood preserver.

Lumber intended to be in contact with the soil should be dipped for a minimum of 5 minutes per inch of thickness.

Lumber not intended to be in contact with the soil may be treated as above, or it can be treated by the brush or spray method giving two or more coats of the product. All cutting, framing and boring should be completed prior to treatment.

TERMITE CONTROL: For protection against termites, treat wood prior to use in construction as outlined above.

FOR BURLAP, DUCK, ROPE, NETS, TEXTILES: Spray or brush the solution onto rope or fabric to the point of runoff, allowing several minutes for absorption. Let dry. Another method is to dip the fabric or rope into the solution for several minutes, then squeeze out remaining liquid and let dry.

Do not use any item treated with this product until the solvents have volatilized from them and they are thoroughly "dry".

ESTIMATED COVERAGE FOR DILUTED PRODUCT: 5 to 10 gallons per thousand board feet for open tank treatment. 200 square feet per gallon for brush application.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a closed, properly labelled container in a cool place. If static generating conditions exist, provide necessary grounding and bonding. Keep containers closed when not in use.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the nearest Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.
