SAPSTAIN CONTROL: Sapstain Control Chemical
NP-30 is used to control sap stain and mold
on freshly cut softwood and hardwood lumber,
logs, poles, posts and timbers. It is applied
by dipping, spraying, or pressure impregnation
of the wood with a dispersion containing 2 to
6 lb (2 to 6 pt) of Sapstain Control Chemical
NP-30 per 100 gal. of water. Initially begin
treatment with the higher dilution level, i.e.,
2 lb (2 pt) NP-30 per 100 gal of water. If
staining or molding should occur, such that
product marketability is affected, increase
strength up to 6 lb (6 pt) per 100 gal. of
water until sap stain or mold control is
achieved. Treatment should be made within
24 hr. of cutting or sawing, particularly in
warm weather, and treated wood should not
be exposed to heavy rains soon after treatment.

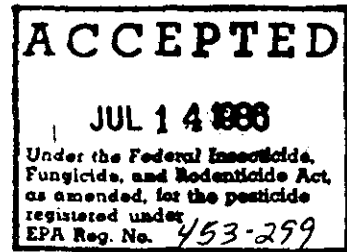
