

To control established grasses such as Johnson, Bermuda, para, quae, ad phragmites (plume grass) on railroad berm and ballast areas, apply ? to 1 gallons of Radapon Liquid per acre-mile after growth is well devel and dur log spring or early summer. Under most conditions 12 gallons per acre-: le suggested. Dilute with sufficient water to give uniform wetting of force (100 or more gallons of spray mix per acre-mile with on-the-track equipment). Formula 40® Weed Killer may be added to spray mix for control of broad-leaved wereas, but contact weed killers which produce rapid foliage burn should not be usea. Undiluted Radapon Liquid is not compatible with and must be diluted before Formula 40 is added. Application of spray wises containing 2,4-D should be delayed until most of the weed seedlings and seasons have emerged. If regrowth of established grasses occurs, make a second application during the same season, using 5 to 8 gallons of Radapon Liquid per acre-mile.
