## NOVEGE WEED AND GRASS KILLER

NOVEGE controls a wide range of vegetation including both grasses and broadleaved weeds. It acts by root and leaf absorption and leaves a temporary residual in the soil for control of weeds as they germinate. Action is slow under dry conditions and several days may be required before effects become fully evident. Control is normally maintained for extended periods up to a full season.

Partial list of species controlled includes: dandelion, lamb's quarters, plantain, Bermudagrass, bluegrass, mustards, pigweed, puncture vine, spotted spurge, water grass, crabgrass.

NOVEGE herbicide is recommended for killing weeds and preventing new weed growth in driveways, walkways, parking areas, under fences, around garages and other buildings, and in similar areas where vegetation is not wanted, and also for edging in various areas.

**PREPARING THE SPRAY:** NOVEGE mixes easily in water with agitation. Add the required amount of NOVEGE to the water and stir until a uniform mixture is obtained. If mixture is allowed to stand, re-stir before using.

**FOR SPRAYER APPLICATION:** Add one quart of NOVEGE to two quarts of water. Spray vegetation to wet. Also spray soil or gravel to prevent new weed seedlings from germinating. Use three quarts of spray mixture on 250 square feet of area for top kill of weeds and temporary prevention of the germination of new weed seedlings. Where weeds are large or it is desired to maintain control for extended periods, treat 100 square feet with three quarts of spray mixture.

**FOR SPRINKLING CAN APPLICATION:** Add one quart of NOVEGE to two gallons of water. Use this amount on 250 square feet of area for top kill of weeds and temporary prevention of the germination of new

weed seedlings. Where weeds are larger or more permanent control is desired, treat 100 square feet with this amount of mixture. Sprinkle as uniformly as possible, wetting both the soil and the growing plants. For uniform results move the sprinkler can rapidly over the area to be treated in one direction and then in the other direction. Wash the sprinkling can with a detergent and water after use.

**CERTAIN HOSE PROPORTIONERS** can be used to spray vegetation, providing that dilution is not more than one quart of NOVEGE to two gallons of water.

For edging walkway, driveway, curb, and similar areas, spray or sprinkle carefully and uniformly a four to six inch band along the edge of the area. Repeat in midseason, if necessary. Do not apply on slope areas where heavy rainfall could wash material to areas with desirable vegetation.

**NOTE:** With any application method, it is important to apply the right amount of chemical on each area treated, regardless of the amount of water used. This dosage is a minimum of one quart of NOVEGE per 250 square feet of area. NOVEGE is not hazardous to use. Does not contain an arsenic. Follow label directions.

### IMPORTANT

It is better to apply NOVEGE before weeds and grass get large and even before weed seedlings germinate. In some areas, the best time to apply is just before or as fall rains start and weeds are beginning to grow. Storage Directions: Do not store NOVEGE at temperatures above 100 F. for extended periods of time. Store only in original containers.

### USE PRECAUTIONS

Do not apply NOVEGE directly to or otherwise permit it to come into contact with desirable turf, vegetables, flowers, field crops, fruit plants, ornamentals, or other such plants. Coarse sprays are less likely to drift. Do not spray over areas where soil may contain roots of desirable shrubs and trees. There may be a slight staining of patio blocks. Clean spray equipment thoroughly before using for other purposes. Do not contaminate irrigation water or water used for domestic purposes.

This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of any body of water. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.
