## GRANULAR INSECTICIDE

*Controls Chinch Bugs and Sod Webworms (Lawn Moths) Infesting Home Lawns and Other Ornamental Turf Areas*

**ACTIVE INGREDIENT:**

Chlorpyrifos [O,O-diethyl O-(3,5,6-trichloro-2-pyridyl) phosphorothioate] ..... 0.5%

**INERT INGREDIENTS:** ..... 99.5%

### USE DIRECTIONS

Apply DURSBAN 1/2 G granular insecticide uniformly to home lawns and other ornamental and recreational turf grass areas using any hand or power operated gravity or rotary type spreader designed for application of granular materials. Treat when insects first appear using DURSBAN 1/2 G at the rate of 200 pounds per acre. To help obtain uniform distribution, apply one-half the required amount of product in one direction; then apply the balance at a right angle. Immediately after application sprinkle the turf with 1300 gallons of water per acre so as to wash the granules into the zone of insect infestation. Consult the following table to determine amounts of DURSBAN 1/2 G and water needed for smaller sized areas. Re-treat as necessary.

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
